<p>Age</p> <p>16 +</p> <p>Group B</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Pay & Play – Partnership with Sports Centres. ➤ Back To Netball. ➤ 6th Form Colleges and Sports Centres – Adverts. ➤ Aims - People who may/not have played the game or who have not been able to make teams for leagues. ➤ Links – From pay to play from weekly social enjoyment to entering leagues/clubs/teams (are there facilities i.e. coaches, clubs,...) ➤ Who runs these? – County, local league, ball halls. ➤ Who is playing? ➤ Affiliation/membership to EN?

<p>Age</p> <p>16 +</p> <p>Group D</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ 19 – 25 – Young Professionals: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Pub teams. - Corporate Teams. - Lunch-time skills sessions. ➤ No Affiliation Fee – pay as you go. ➤ Men: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Girl's playing football to also play netball. - Mixed tournaments. - Links with 'male' sports. ➤ Universities: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Link Club to Uni. - Built on 'Cultural Societies' Links. - Coaching/Official opportunities. - Recreational Uni rep teams. ➤ Parents: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Links to leisure centre – crèche. - Mother's and Daughter's Days. - Links to Schools.
